In early 2021, our partner RHYCO opened the Bella Ciao Safe House and Drop-In Centre for street children in Kawangware slum. The main objective and driving force of the RHYCO team is to **improve the quality of life for young people who are born into extreme poverty.** 

In just two short years, the centre has made a huge impression on the children and families they serve, as well as the surrounding community. Their approach is holistic, which means they **focus on developing the whole child** and providing 'Real Hope'.

Here's a snapshot of their amazing work.

#### **Daily priorities at Bella Ciao**

- Rescue children in need of protection from abuse
- Run programs for children who can't afford school
- · Operate an informal school and homework club
- · Provide nutritional meals and medical support
- Reintegrate the children into their schools and homes

#### Long-term development activities

- Provide leadership training to expand the children's potential
   Help parents deal with substance abuse and unemployment
   Get the community's help to divert children from street life
- Engage in advocacy with the government
- Break the grip of poverty in Kawangware ... one life at a time

# WALKE VATER Contraction of the second second

## The walk is fast approaching!

With help from Women Making a Difference, International Needs Canada is raising funds for a large water and sanitation project in the village of Kona, Burkina Faso. **The 5km "Walk for Water" is happening on June 3rd in Cottam, Ontario.** 

It all started with a gospel outreach led by International Needs Burkina Faso in the rural village of Lah. After the event, the village leaders expressed how badly their people were suffering from a lack of clean water: "You've brought us water for our souls; can you also bring water for our bodies?"

With help from Women Making a Difference, International Needs Canada was pleased to raise the funds needed to drill two boreholes. A year later, clean and safe water was flowing for about 3000 people!





The second project is now being built in Kokoro, another small community that has no source of water nearby.

Women and girls travel long distances for hours a day to fetch contaminated water that makes everyone sick. The project includes two boreholes and five badly-needed public latrines to improve sanitation.

Proceeds from the Walk for Water will be for the third project in Kona.

## 1. Discovery Tour

#### The Joy of Child Sponsorship

Every year, International Needs Canada hosts Discovery Tours that give you the opportunity to travel to our partner countries and **visit the many projects and programs** that support vulnerable children and women. In February 2023, Corrie Mulder led a tour to Bangladesh with a small group of supporters.

Long-time child sponsors Fran and Keith were on the tour, and they enjoyed seeing the **great work taking place at the schools and drop-in centres**. As they travelled around the country, they heard the sad stories of children who had been abandoned and forgotten.

The highlight of the trip was meeting Hashi and Pronoy, two children they've been sponsoring for the last ten years. Many young girls Hashi's age are at risk of being sold into early marriage or child labour, common practices in Bangladesh. And they were excited to hear Pronoy talk about the future, and his plans to become a doctor.

Thanks to Fran and Keith's support, these two fine young people are **attending wonderful schools and on a path to a better life.** When their family and friends ask about the trip, they describe it as "awesome and heavy. It was a great experience, but very emotional".

#### The Impact of Group Sponsorship

In fall 2022, two teams went on medical outreaches: one to Zambia, and one to Ghana. Over 21 days total, these volunteers visited nine International Needs schools and **served more than 5000 men, women, and children** who have no access to medical care.

The Zambia medical team discovered that food insecurity is a serious challenge at ZACTS school, where an estimated **80% of all students come to school without breakfast.** Among primary grades, the absenteeism rate due to food insecurity is 25%; the children are just too weak and unable to concentrate on their studies.

The medical team was heartbroken to see the children suffering, so they **started a group sponsorship feeding program** to make sure all students at ZACTS benefit from a healthy meal every day. 960 students, mainly those not already receiving the benefits of sponsorship, will eat well for the next five years. **Thanks to everyone on the team for their compassion and generosity!**
